ENTRY REGULATIONS

All owners of entrants are encouraged to study the requirements of the tests for which they are entered. Full test rules/regulations, including permitted actions, will be available on the day; alternatively, a copy may be obtained from the NNC (contact the Test Manager).

Eligibility: No dog may enter a level unless they hold a pass at each preceding level from an event organised by NNC, SNC, or NC. Exception: a dog passing Section A for the first time may enter Section B on the same day if put forward by the judges, subject to age and available time.

Entry forms: Every entry form must be completed in full and accompanied by the correct fee or it will not be accepted. One form per dog. A dog may be entered for multiple levels on the same form. New members apply for membership to the Test Manager or Secretary; membership is subject to Committee approval.

Right to refuse: The Committee/Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entries.

Briefing: All entrants must attend the Judges' briefing at 9:00 am prompt (tests commence at 9:30 am). Entrants who miss the briefing will only be admitted at the discretion of the Test Manager.

Dogs on site: Owners are responsible for their dogs at all times. Exercising dogs in the defined test area is prohibited. Dogs must be kept on a lead within 25 m of the test area. No dog other than the dog under test may enter the test area. All owners must clear up after their dogs at all times.

Judge substitution: Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling their engagement, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge in their place. Entrants may withdraw from the tests, but no entry fee will be returned.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded except by permission of the Committee. A bitch coming into season unexpectedly after entries close may apply for a 90% refund with a confirming vet certificate.

Event cancellation: Whilst every effort will be made to test all entrants on the day, due to circumstances beyond the control of the Committee/Organisers this may not be possible. In that event, all entries that have registered on the day will receive a full refund.

Passes: Passes will not be sent out. Enclose an SAE with your entry if you require acknowledgement.

Disqualification: A dog and handler may be immediately disqualified and removed for: infectious disease; interference with other entrants; dangerous temperament; likelihood of suffering; a bitch in season; or punitive/harsh handling within the event boundaries. If a dog is disqualified for any of these reasons and has already passed a test at the event, that pass will be rescinded, and a report will be provided by the Test Manager to the Working Sub-Committee.

PPE: Everyone in the test area must wear a wetsuit or drysuit with appropriate footwear and a personal flotation device. This applies to judges, handlers, stewards, helm, boat stewards, and stranger stewards.

Judges' decision: The Judges' decision in all matters relating to the tests is final. In the event of disagreement between judges, the Test Manager acts as Referee. The Committee will adjudicate on any dispute that remains unresolved on the day or has been notified in writing to the Test Manager within 7 days.

Liability: The Club cannot accept responsibility for any accident, injury, or loss to persons, dogs, or property at the event.

Children: Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children at all times.

Spectators wishing to attend should contact the Test Manager the day before to confirm the event is proceeding.
