Re: Revised Age of Junior Handlers at NNC Test Events

Dear Members,

Following our recent WSC meeting, it has come to our attention, that the age limit for junior handlers covered by the NNC event insurance is restricted to children aged 12 years old and above.

Historically, the test event schedules have limited the age from aged 10 years and above, which is obviously not in line with the insurance requirements.

The WSC have therefore needed to review the minimum age for junior handlers so that it is now a minimum of 12 years old for any NNC test events.

This will be enforced at the upcoming Manvers Lake NNC Water test to be held Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th of August and for all future NNC test events, until further notice.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause to entrants, but I am sure you will understand that we must adhere to the requirements of the NNC insurance policy, and ensure that our entrants to tests are safeguarded, in the event of any accidents.

We thank you for your compliance and understanding.
